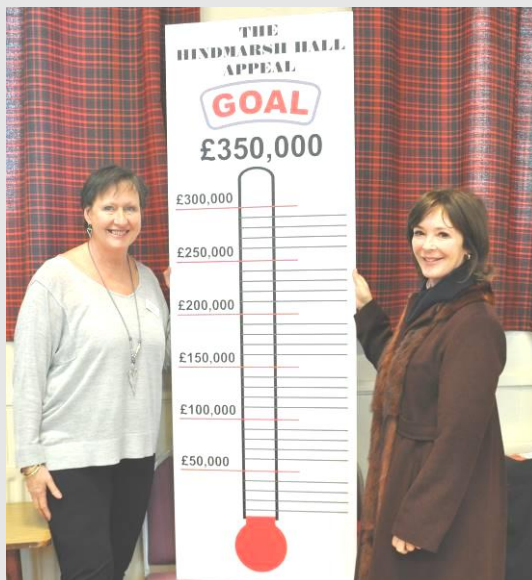
In late 2009 the Parish Council decided that Alnmouth could benefit from having some regular means of telling residents what was happening in the village. The result was the first Newsletter (right), which was published in December of that year. Funded by the PC, the Newsletter is distributed to every property in the parish and emailed to more than 70 recipients throughout the UK and overseas. It also has its own website (www.alnmouth.info) which in a typical month gets around 600 "hits" mainly from the UK, but in January, for example, it was opened in 50 countries. Issue 1 was concerned about access to the village being cut off due to cracks appearing in the highway by the Wellfield development. Since then we have covered



numerous topics, some serious like the arson attack at Seabank and of course parking and the one-way system. There have been numerous Arts Festivals, Raft Races, Volcano Nights, Alnmouth Shows, Christmas Lights, New Year's Day Swims, Church Fetes and more coffee mornings than we can count. But the Newsletter can only be as good as the information you send to it – so it depends on you, the reader, to keep it and your fellow readers informed as to what is happening. Thank you for the many messages of support that have been received over the years and thank you to that small group of people who every month brave the elements to post a copy through your letterbox.

Duchess Launches Hindmarsh Hall Appeal Fund



A packed Hindmarsh Hall saw the Duchess of Northumberland officially launch the appeal to refurbish the building.
